- **Sunday evening welcome dinner and lunches Monday through Thursday. Breakfast is included with overnight accommodations Monday-Friday.**
- **Wednesday evening picnic.**
- **Admission to Fort Ticonderoga and all other fees**
- **All class sessions, teacher resources, books, and handouts**
- **Overnight accommodations for five nights (Sunday night through Friday morning) based on double-occupancy. A limited number of private rooms may be available—teachers pay \$90/night for a private room.**
