## A Rebellion . . . made possible by you . . . defined by Defiance, Independence and Hope



Anyone who walks Fort Ticonderoga's hallowed ground cannot help but be moved by its power and beauty. Each chapter of its story—its 18th-

century revolution, 19th-century preservation and 20th-century restoration—has revealed “rebels” who defied the status quo, blazing a path towards a compelling vision of independence and hope for the future.

Today one hears the sounds of another rebellion, one of thought and ideas redefining the Fort's historic site experience. Visitors are finding an innovative model for absorbing history through Fort Ticonderoga's dramatic stories that transcend time and place.

In 2012, we began a process of highlighting these stories one year at a time. This bold advance in historical interpretation enhances our mission, allowing for an honest recreation of the lives we interpret as well as a careful analysis of specific events that punctuate our history.

Our first story told visitors of 1775, the pivotal year when a band of rebels challenged the British Empire and secured America's first victory of the American

Revolution. Faced with a crumbling infrastructure, limited resources and uncertain politics, the fate of the Fort and this fledging rebellion was uncertain. It slowly took hold as troops were recruited, resources allocated and leadership developed. 1775 was *the* crucial, early-momentum year of the Revolutionary era. Hope for an independent nation had emerged.

Likewise, 2012 was a crucial, early-momentum year for us. We were challenged to better use our resources and develop strategies to test emerging ideas as we continued to plan for the future. The results were remarkable. Defying negative trends facing similar sites across North America, Fort Ticonderoga has, in short, undergone a turnaround.

Fort Ticonderoga is surrounded by three mountains – Defiance, Independence, and Hope. While not much more than hills at 853, 306, and 320 feet respectively, their historical significance to Fort Ticonderoga is disproportionate to their size. By extension, we are deeply grateful for every gift of support, no matter the size. There is no telling what our small, but dedicated band of rebels might achieve. By joining together, we may even be able to redefine the possible!

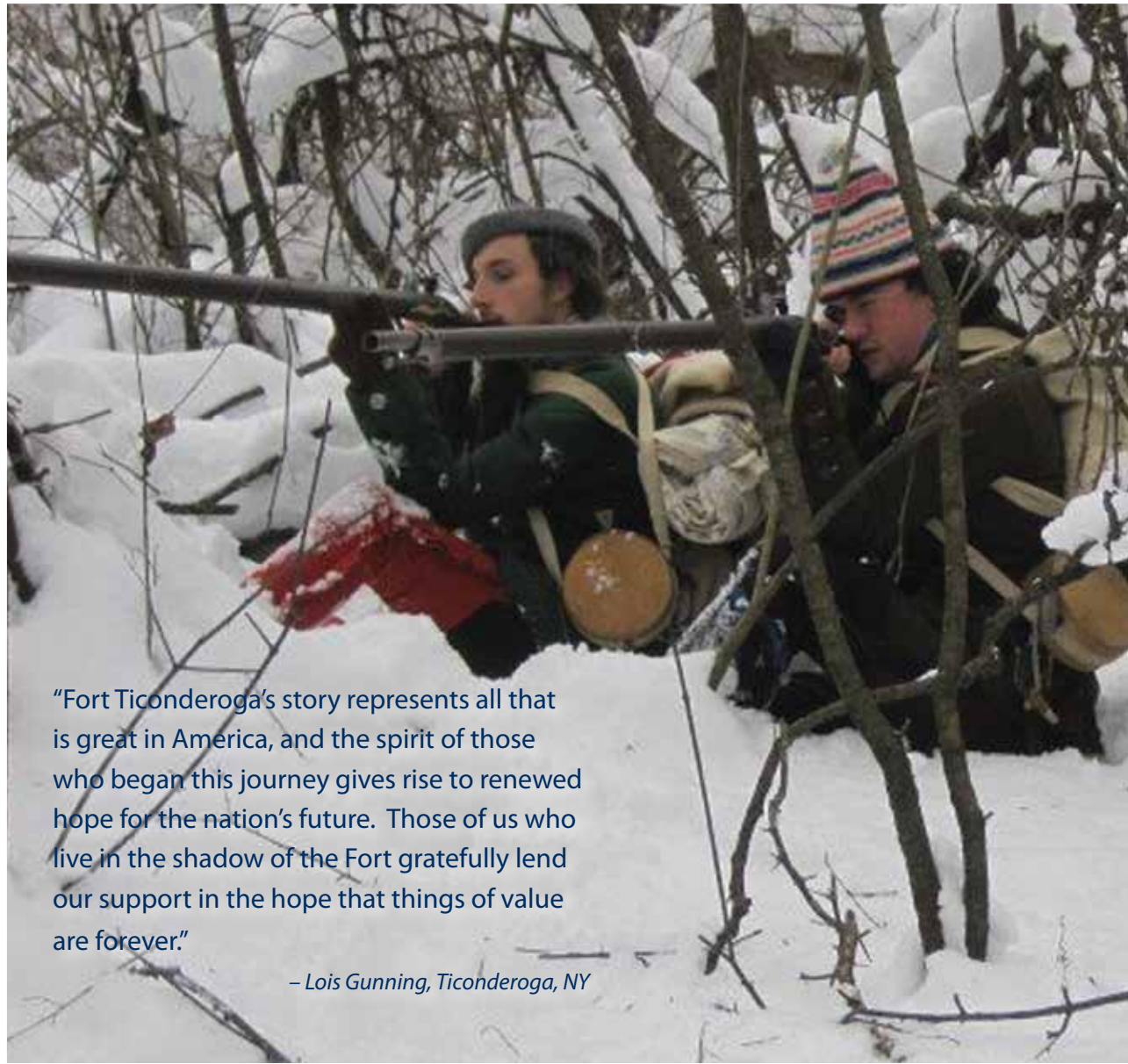


