



Defiance & Independence Re-enactor Schedule 2021

Friday, July 23

1:00 PM to 11:00 PM Registration Open in British and Continental Camps

Entering the Fort through the lower entrance to the site, participants should proceed towards their respective camps and go to sign-in. British registration will be past our admissions booth, adjacent to the British Camp. Continental Registration will be along the road to the King's Garden. After signing-in participants will be shown to camping lines and advised about the best means of unloading tents & other camp equipment.

Participants should remove their vehicles to their respective camps' parking areas as soon as possible.

British Participants will need to drive out Fort Ticonderoga's exit road, reentering below to access parking.

5:00 PM Fort Ticonderoga Closes to Visitors

7:00 PM Officers' Meeting

British & Continental Officers will meet by the Recreated Redoubt.

11:00 PM Tattoo

Participants should head back to their tents or quarters for the night.

Saturday, July 24

7:00 AM Reveille

7:00 AM to 9:00 AM Registration Open in British and Continental Camps

Any late arrivals should sign-in at registration in their respective camps. Unit commanders should ensure that later arrivals sign-in as well.

All vehicles must be removed to parking no later than 9:00 AM.

9:30 AM Fort Ticonderoga Opens to Visitors

10:00 AM Inspection of the Armies (Inside the Fort's Parade Ground and in the British Camp)

All British and Continental units will form up on their respective parades for inspection of arms as well as orders for the day.

12:30 PM Assembly for Battle

Continental forces should be ready to march promptly at 12:30 in order to march up the Heights of Carillon. Continental Forces are encouraged to carry packs. British forces are encouraged to field without camp equipment (excepting canteens). It is the responsibility

of unit commanders to inspect any arms that were not present at the 10:00 AM formation.

1:00 PM Re-enactment Battle: Evacuate Mount Hope (Below the Recreated Redoubt)

1:30 PM Artillery Vignette (At the Recreated Redoubt)

5:00 PM Fort Ticonderoga Closes to Visitors

11:00 PM Tattoo

Participants should head back to their tents or quarters for the night.

Sunday, July 25

7:00 AM Reveille

9:30 AM Fort Ticonderoga Opens to Visitors

10:00 AM Inspection of the Armies (Inside the Fort's Parade Ground and the British Camp)

At the sound of *the General* Continental soldiers are highly encouraged to break camp, packing knapsacks and rolling tents in preparation to evacuate Ticonderoga.

12:45 PM Assembly for Battle

Continental Forces are encouraged, but not required, to carry packs. British forces are encouraged to field without camp equipage (excepting canteens).

1:00 PM Re-enactment Battle: "We Must March Back" (At the Recreated Redoubt)

1:30 PM Fort Ticonderoga Capture Vignette (In Front of Fort Ticonderoga)

2:00 PM Re-enactment Battle: "Boats deeply laden with cannon, tents, provisions, invalids and women." (King's Garden)

4:00 PM Vehicles Allowed into Camp

5:00 Fort Ticonderoga Closes to Visitors
