

Defiance & Independence Re-enactor Schedule 2023

Friday

1:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Registration Open in British and Continental Camps

Entering the Fort through the lower entrance to the site, participants should proceed towards their respective camps and go to sign-in. British registration will be past our admissions booth, adjacent to the British Camp. Continental Registration will be along the exit road on the left. After signing-in participants will be shown to camping lines and advised about the best means of unloading tents & other camp equipment.

****Participants should remove their vehicles to reenactor parking as soon as possible.****

5:00 p.m. Fort Ticonderoga Closes to Visitors

7:00 p.m. Officers' Meeting

British & Continental Officers will meet by the Recreated Redoubt.

11:00 p.m. Tattoo

Participants should head back to their tents or quarters for the night.

Saturday

7:00 a.m. Reveille

7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Registration Open in British and Continental Camps

Any late arrivals should sign-in at registration in their respective camps. Unit commanders should ensure that later arrivals sign-in as well.

****All vehicles must be removed to parking no later than 9:00 a.m.****

9:30 a.m. Fort Ticonderoga Opens to Visitors

10:00 a.m. Inspection of the Armies (Inside the Fort's Parade Ground and in the British Camp)

All British and Continental units will form up on their respective parades for inspection of arms as well as orders for the day.

12:30 p.m. Assembly for Battle

Continental forces should be ready to march promptly at 12:30 p.m. in order to march up the Heights of Carillon. Continental Forces are encouraged to carry packs. British forces are encouraged to field without camp equipage (excepting canteens). It is the responsibility of unit commanders to inspect any arms that were not present at the 10:00 a.m. inspection.

1:00 p.m. Reenactment Battle: Evacuate Mount Hope (Saturday Woods Battlefield)

At the conclusion of this battle reenactment, British forces should return to their camp, avoiding the Recreated Redoubt. Continental forces are welcome to reform behind the Recreated Redoubt in preparation for the following vignette.

1:30 p.m. Artillery Vignette (At the Recreated Redoubt)

5:00 p.m. Fort Ticonderoga Closes to Visitors

8:00 p.m. Assembly for Evening Program

Units or individuals taking part in the evening's special programs should assemble at your respective assigned position for briefing and orders. Please hide all modern items in camps.

11:00 p.m. Tattoo

Participants should head back to their tents or quarters for the night.

Sunday

7:00 a.m. Reveille

9:30 a.m. Fort Ticonderoga Opens to Visitors

10:00 a.m. Inspection of the Armies (Inside the Fort's Parade Ground and the British Camp)

At the sound of *the General* Continental participants are highly encouraged to break camp, packing knapsacks and rolling tents in preparation to evacuate Ticonderoga.

12:45 p.m. Assembly for Battle

Continental forces are encouraged to carry packs. British forces are encouraged to field without camp equipment (excepting canteens).

1:00 p.m. Reenactment Battle: "We Must March Back" (At the Recreated Redoubt)

At the conclusion of this reenactment battle, participants are encouraged to drink and refill their canteens.

1:40 p.m. Reenactment Battle: "Boats deeply laden with cannon, tents, provisions, invalids and women." (King's Garden)

At the conclusion of this reenactment battle, Continental participants will proceed to the King's Road adjacent to the King's Garden, heading back to camp.
