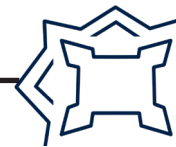


Girl Scout Badges and Journeys

Badges

Outdoor Art Expert

Explore the King's Garden or take a hike on our Carillon Battlefield trail to get inspired to create an art project on the environment surrounding Fort Ticonderoga. Take a look at our online collections database of drawings and photographs to better understand how the environment around the fort has changed over time.

Truth Seeker

Use a critical eye in our exhibit spaces to research the experiences of soldiers or someone following the army. Look at our online collections database to examine bias in historical sources or items and analyze how to draw your own conclusions!



Novelist

Use your experience at Fort Ticonderoga creatively by writing a novel! Visit our tailors and learn about the lives of regimental tailors, or try on clothing to better understand what your character may wear. Visit the barracks spaces and try the bunks to see where a character may sleep or smell what's cooking for a soldier's dinner to uncover first hand what they may be eating!

Textile Artist

Visit our experienced tailors to inspire your own textile project! See what materials and tools tailors use to create clothing. Understand how math and geometry fit into the trade and uncover how tailors were able to reuse materials.

Think Like an Engineer

Watch a cannon demonstration, see how our oxen pull heavy loads, examine the architecture of Fort Ticonderoga or learn how bateaux travel on the water to see the engineering ideas they involve.
