OVERALL ACCESSIBILITY & SENSORY NOTES

TRANSPORT & MOBILITY

1. No shuttle services available.
2. Driving is recommended to travel between different areas.
3. Not every area is wheelchair accessible.
4. Roads are a combination of paved and gravel. Most footpaths are dirt or gravel.
5. Two parking lots are available....

PLANNING YOUR VISIT

1. Open for visitation Tuesday - Sunday from May - October.
2. July to September is the peak season and crowds may be expected during this time.
3. Outdoor spaces can experience a wide range of climatic conditions based on the season, please consult local weather forecasts when planning your visit.
4. Those with severe pollen reactions or bee allergies are advised to carry relevant medications.
5. Dogs on-leashes are allowed at areas across the site except for building interiors and the King's Garden. (Exceptions are made for service dogs)

AMENITIES & FACILITIES

1. Campus-wide WiFi is available. Signal Strength may vary depending on location.
2. Visitors may encounter limited cell reception, but it has been observed that AT&T and Verizon networks work better.
3. Wheelchairs can be borrowed from the Log House Welcome Center with limited availability
4. American Sign Language (ASL) guides are not currently available.

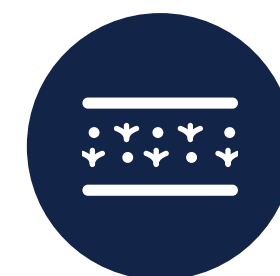
The King's Garden & Pavilion

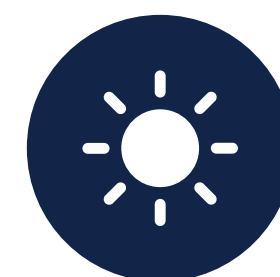

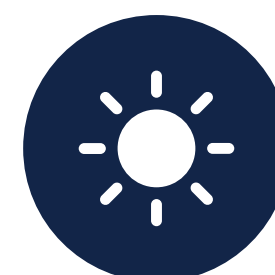

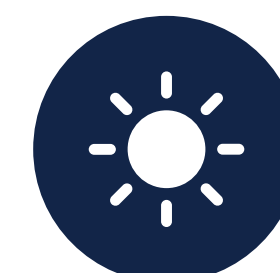

Restored Pell family country home, housing administrative offices, and available for rental. Ticketed specialty tours available seasonally.



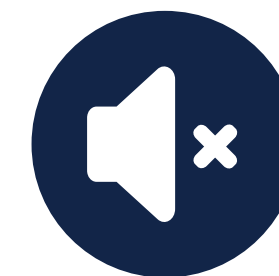

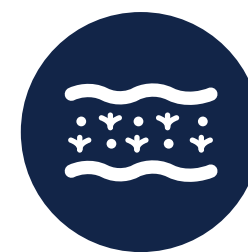

An open 6-acre area encompassing a range of gardens, including the historic walled garden with irregular brick paths and grassy areas, as well as many additional garden plots for flowers, produce, and a children's garden with dirt and grass paths. Also includes a greenhouse and outbuildings and a paddock which sometimes contains farm animals as well as the Pell family cemetery. Picnic area and portable toilet available as well as a vending machine for bottled water.



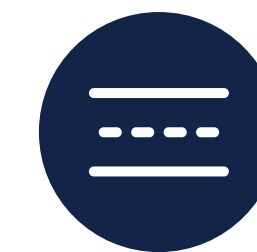

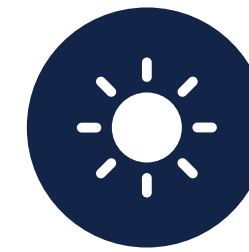

Carillon Battlefield Hiking Trail

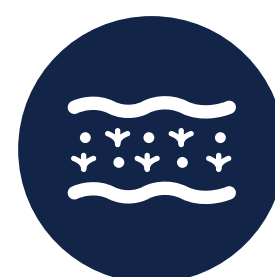
CARILLON BATTLEFIELD

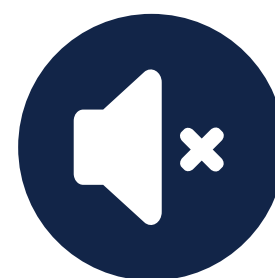

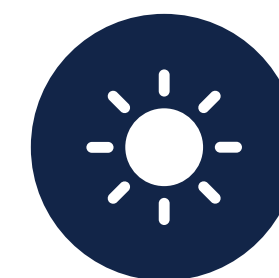

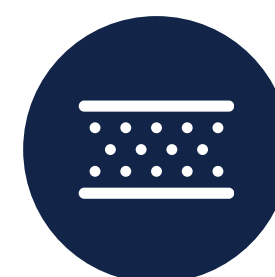


Fort Ticonderoga
